

Transportation from the airport to Marist

- Marist provides free taxis for students who follow these instructions.
 - Two or more people must travel together to have free transportation.
 - You must provide an address where you will go when you first arrive in New York. The taxi needs a place to take you. Make sure you have immediate access.
 - \circ $\;$ Each person must provide their flight itinerary and a destination for the cab.
 - Request your taxi ride at least one week before you arrive, preferably sooner.
- Taxis arranged by Marist are completely paid for by Marist, including tolls and tips. You do not have to pay the driver anything.
- Free taxis ARE NOT provided on major holidays: Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, New Year's Eve, New Year's Day for the Spring semester.
- Taxis can cost \$400 for a private ride to the Marist area. Make arrangements early for a free ride.
- Fly to either Newark Liberty Airport (EWR) or John F Kennedy International Airport (JFK)
- Arrive in Poughkeepsie at least one day before Orientation
 - Orientation is Wednesday through Friday before classes start.

- The first day you are allowed to enter the country is stated on your I-20.
- You will receive taxi confirmation by email or WhatsApp. Your driver will meet you at the airport as you exit Customs. The driver will be holding a sign with Marist's name.
- Seniors may offer to transport you and may charge you to cover their expenses.

Temporary housing for your first one or two nights.

- You need a place for the taxi to take you and your luggage when you first arrive to New York.
- If you have arranged rental housing you still will need to meet the landlord to gain access. You will need a hotel or a friend's apartment to stay in when you first reach Poughkeepsie. Do not plan to go immediately to the rental.
- Most students go to Quality Inn Hotel when they first arrive, or they go to a current student's apartment.
- If you arrive in New York without securing housing, plan to stay in a hotel room for several nights, perhaps up to two weeks.
